## The Patient Assistance Program

Our free prescription program is available to anyone who meets the requirements listed below:

- You have been prescribed a Johnson & Johnson donated medication
- You meet the eligibility income requirements for the product(s)
- You don't have any insurance or your medicine is not covered
  - Some patients with Medicare Prescription Drug Coverage (Part D) who cannot afford their medicines and who meet certain financial criteria may also be eligible for assistance
- You live in the United States or a U.S. Territory
- You are being treated by a U.S. licensed doctor as an outpatient

## How the program works

- The Patient Assistance Program covers over 40 prescription products\*, including:
  - INVOKANA® (canagliflozin) tablets
  - REMICADE® (infliximab) IV infusion
  - XARELTO® (rivaroxaban) tablets
  - ZYTIGA® (abiraterone acetate) tablets
- Once you meet program requirements and are approved you'll receive your medications for up to one year
- You may be able to reapply to the program annually
- It's free to apply and you only need to complete one application
